

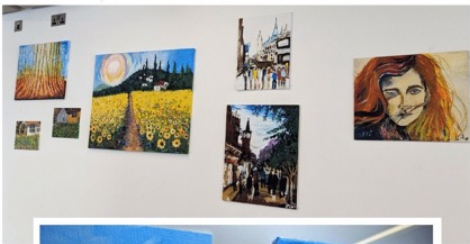


Headway Art Exhibition

Clients Steve and Julia love having a game of Scrabble on a Thursday at Worcester Daycentre.

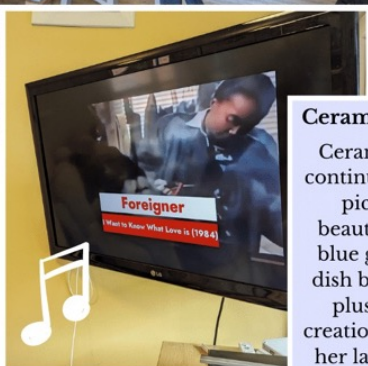
Steve, who normally is more confident in number-based games, has been tough competition, often being crowned the winner!

Ceramic sessions continue to be a hit; pictured is a beautiful red and blue glazed floral dish by client Mel, plus Mel mid-creation working on her latest project.



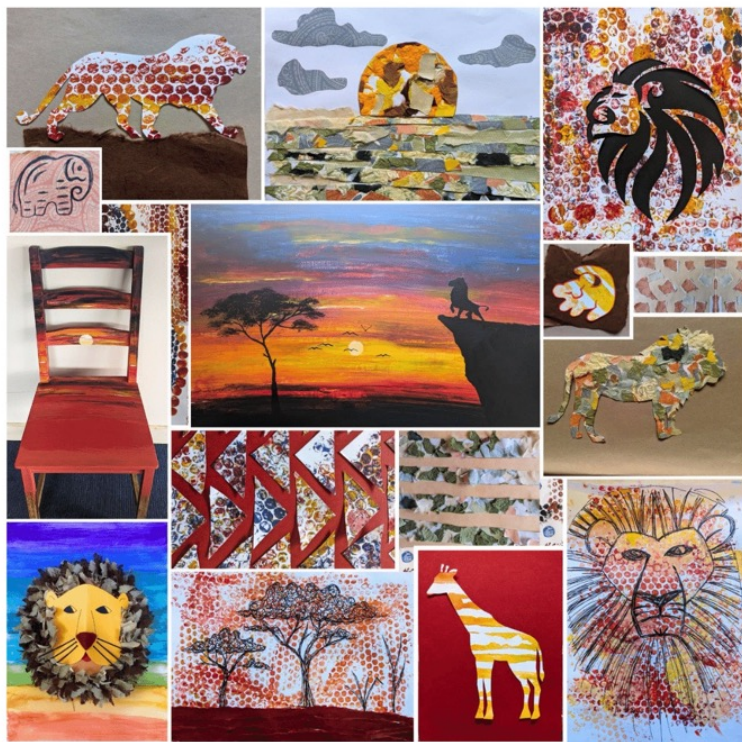


Worcester Film Festival
